#### Calendar Discussion

- Concern about vacation timing. Easter Holy Week vs. Bright Week
- Currently scheduled next year for Holy Week. Could potentially change. Requires submission to State and support from community
- Previously, Priest and site council had recommended Holy Week.
- Many community have expressed desire for a change

### **Teacher Report**

- HS Finished Fahrenheit 451 before break. Will finish school through differentiated projects. Gained inspiration from Early Release book read Delivering the Promise. Students will choose standards to cover. Excited to try new stuff. MS will use a self-paced approach in language arts, learning with their own timing.

### **Project Grad**

- Phlight club last month in Soldotna
  - Integrated youth development. Strength based. Help them explore their web of support and the adult anchors in their life (who can support their dreams/goals)
  - Twice a year
  - Some Nanwalek students not going because they didn't want to leave/fly
    - Tried a "blast" that we focused locally on some Friday/Saturdays
- Unity conference in California. Charlotte and Nadia attended.
- CloseUp in Juneau
- Career Vocational/Technical visits (AVTEC, KPC, etc.)
- May/June – Summer Institute (for 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> more interested in college/university)
  - Many programs, classes, focuses, plus activities
  - Eligible for \$4,000 scholarship if you attend two years of SI
- Grant evaluator visiting soon
- ACT engage (2<sup>nd</sup> time this year). Survey of their ideas about education.
- Gear Up grant being submitted (every 3 years)
